COURSE INFORMATION

COURSE LOCATION

The course will be held at our indoor training facility, located at: 21291 Urdahl Road NW, Poulsbo, WA 98370 ([See pages 3, 8-12 for driving directions](#)).

COURSE TIME

The gate to the parking lot and the door to Gravitec are locked until 7:30 a.m. Our doors open at 7:30 a.m. Courses begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. (unless otherwise specified) and end at approximately 4:30 p.m. Students are asked to arrive on time. Courses do not conclude early on the last day so please keep this in mind when making your travel arrangements.

PARKING: Free parking is available in front of our office. The gate to the parking lot will open at 7:30 a.m.

STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students are advised to bring the following:

- Comfortable clothing for climbing (jeans, coveralls, etc.). Shorts are **not** allowed.
- Safety toe shoes are **required**. Sneakers, loafers, casual, or open-toed shoes are not permitted inside the hands-on training environment.
- Gravitec will supply all fall protection and rescue equipment for training. Students can bring their own hard hat (minimum 3-point suspension strap is required) and full body harness (with front, back and side D-rings) along with their other fall protection PPE.
- Rope access courses will have all equipment supplied for training. Students can bring their own hard hat (minimum 3-point suspension strap is required).
- If you're enrolled in the Qualified Fall Protection Person course, please bring a laptop computer and a scientific calculator. You will **not need climbing attire** for the **Qualified Fall Protection Person** or **Managed Fall Protection Program Administrator** course.

- Expect training to run to 4:30 p.m. on final day. Plan travel accordingly.
- Please be advised that **video/audio recording** of any kind is **not permitted** at Gravitec's training facility.
- **We recommend that you bring a laptop or tablet to class, as we have recently introduced a new Learning Management System (LMS) called Gravitec University.** This platform performs best on laptops and tablets, although it is also accessible via smartphones. Please note that several modules in the LMS must be completed before the start of class. Additionally, the final exam will be administered through the LMS on the last day of the course.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- During your training here, your safety and well-being are of our utmost concern, and as such, we have instituted the following list of safety guidelines.
- Students must adhere to all of their instructor's safety instructions. Students must remain fully engaged while on the ground on the training floor.
- Students must be tied off 100% of the time while climbing structures.
- There will be no horseplay on the training floor, including jumping off a ladder rung. Students must descend down the full length of ladders.
- Students will wear appropriate climbing clothes on the training floor (no shorts, skirts, or tanktops). This includes full-fingered gloves and safety-toe shoes. **Gravitec will not provide gloves.** Students will use Gravitec-provided, ANSI-rated helmets. Students may use their own climbing gear, but this gear must be inspected and approved by the instructor prior to using it at height.
- **No cameras or video recording is allowed.**

HOW TO GET TO GRAVITEC

- You are responsible for making your own travel arrangements. If you're traveling by air, you should plan to arrive the day prior to the scheduled course date.
- Transportation and lodging will be at your own expense.

TRAVEL BY AIR

Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) is the nearest international airport, located 70.8 miles (1 hour 20 minutes) from Gravitec and approximately 14 miles from the Seattle Ferry Terminal. Although we recommend a rental car for your transportation needs, there are several ground transportation options offered from SEA to downtown Seattle.

Paine Field (KPAE), also known as Snohomish County Airport, is located 1 hour and 37 minutes away from Gravitec via the Kingston/Edmonds Ferry.

RENTAL CARS

All rental car companies at SEA now operate out of a single Consolidated Rental Car Facility located at **3150 S. 160th St.**, which is about 2 miles away from the terminal.

To get there, you must take a dedicated 24-hour shuttle bus. These shuttles pick up passengers at two locations on the Baggage Claim level:

North End: Outside near Door 26 (near Alaska Airlines).

South End: Outside near Door 2 (near the Int. Arrivals).

TAXIS

Taxi cabs and Ride Share Companies are available on the third floor of the Sea-Tac Airport parking garage. Taxi cabs often pick up from the third floor of the parking garage as well, specifically at the north and south ends, and service all destinations in the Kitsap County area.

FERRIES

The Washington State Ferries (WSF) carry both walk-on passengers and vehicles. The WSF schedule is available online at: wsdot.wa.gov/ferries. Click on "Schedules" in the middle of the page, then "Schedule by route." Select "**Seattle/Bainbridge Island**" or "**Edmonds/Kingston**."

1 LINE LIGHT RAIL (CENTRAL SEATAC/AIRPORT LIGHT RAIL)

The 1 Line Light Rail offers a quick, inexpensive and environmentally friendly way to travel to and from downtown Seattle/SeaTac Airport.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Travelers to Poulsbo from Seattle-Tacoma Airport can take the scenic 35-minute ferry across the Puget Sound from Downtown Seattle to Bainbridge Island. The Agate Pass Bridge connects Bainbridge Island to the rest of the Kitsap Peninsula via Highway 305. You can also access the Kitsap Peninsula from Tacoma (South) via Highway 16 and the Tacoma Narrows Bridge or from the Olympic Peninsula (West) via the Hood Canal Bridge.

If you're traveling from Downtown Seattle:

- Take the scenic 35-minute ferry across the Puget Sound from Downtown Seattle to Bainbridge Island.
- Exit the Ferry Dock onto Olympic Dr SE (0.3 mi)
- Continue to follow Hwy 305 N (13.4 mi)
- Turn left onto Olhava Way NW (0.5 mi)
- Turn right onto NW Finn Hill Rd (0.2 mi)
- Turn right onto Urdahl Rd NW (466 ft)
- Turn left into the 1st driveway.

Our office is located 14.5 miles from the Bainbridge Island Ferry Terminal. See detailed driving directions on **pages 8 & 9**.

If you're traveling from Tacoma and South:

- Take I-5 South. Exit 132B for Washington State Route 16 West toward Bremerton.
- Take Washington State Route 16 West to Washington State Route 3 North toward Bremerton/Poulsbo.
- Exit Finn Hill Rd and turn left and take the third right onto Urdahl Rd NW.
- Turn left into the 1st driveway.

If you're traveling from Edmonds or North Seattle to Poulsbo:

- Exit ferry onto State Route 104 W toward NE East 1st St (456 ft)
- Ferry traffic flows onto NE 1st St / SR 104
- Stay on WA-104 W/State Route 104 W (3.7 mi)
- Continue straight onto WA-307 S/Bond Rd NE
Continue to follow Bond Rd NE (5.7 mi)
- Turn right onto NW Lindvig Way (0.2 mi)
- Continue onto NW Finn Hill Rd (0.9 mi)
- Turn right onto Urdahl Rd NW (0.3 mi)
- Turn left into the 1st driveway.

If you're traveling from the Olympic Peninsula or West:

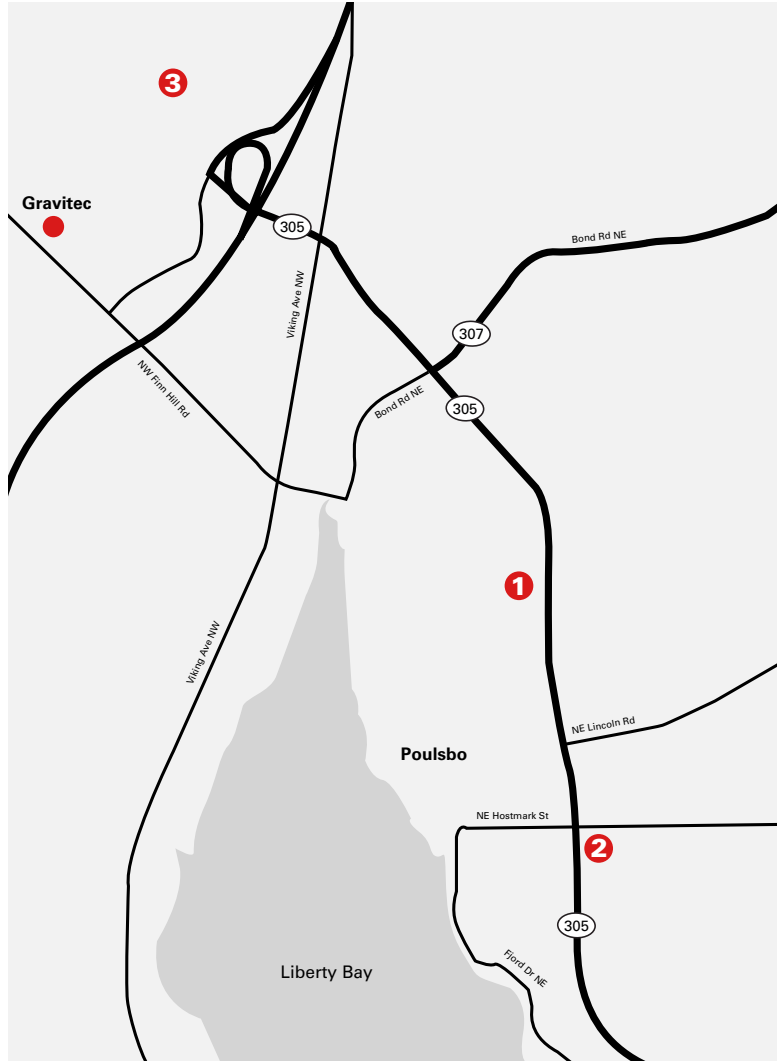
- Take Washington State Route 104 across the Hood Canal Bridge.
- Turn right onto Washington State Route 3 South.
- Take the Washington State Route 305 South exit toward Poulsbo/Bainbridge Island. Merge onto Olhava Way NW.
- Turn right onto NW Finn Hill Road. Take the first right onto Urdahl Road NW.
- Turn left into the 1st driveway.

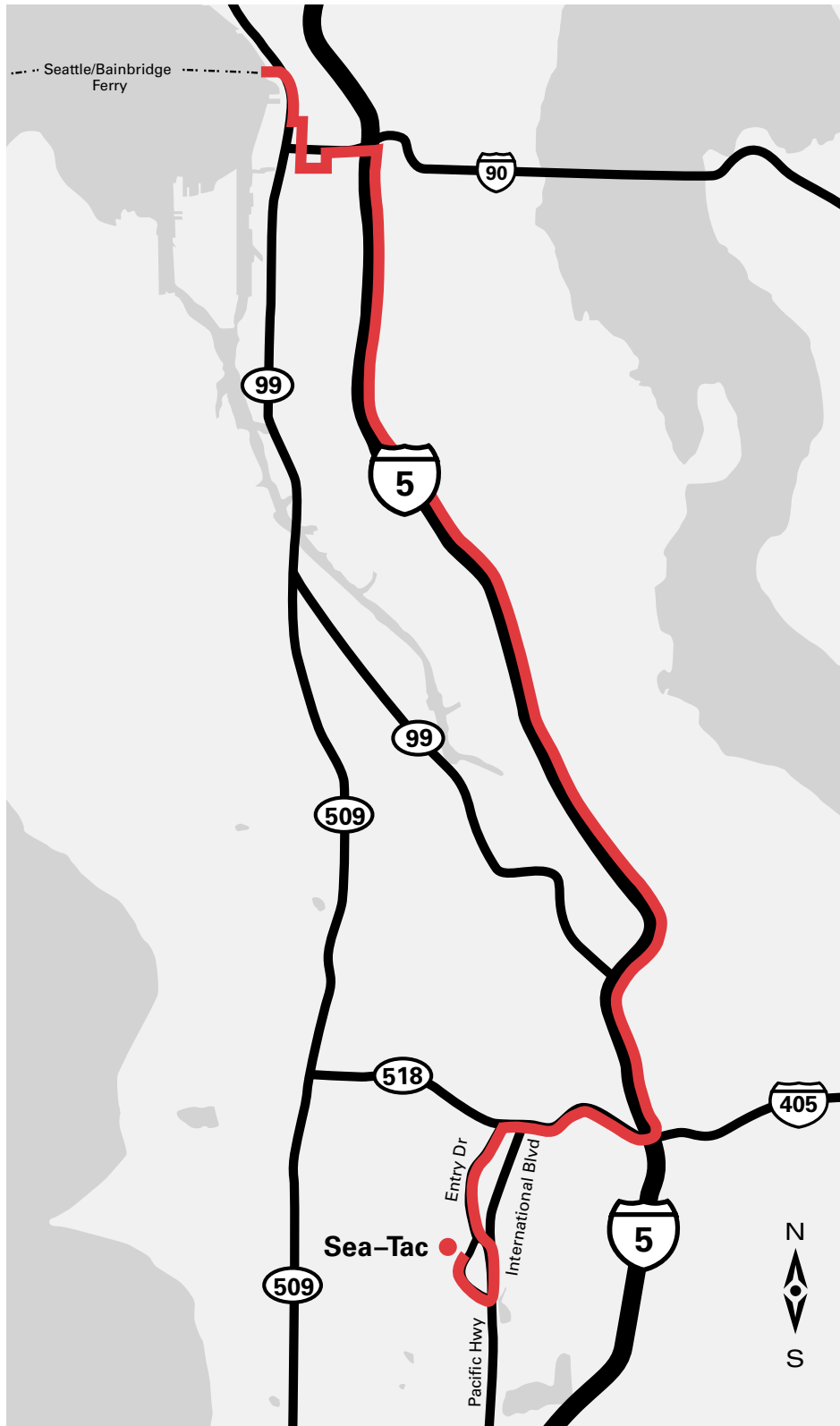

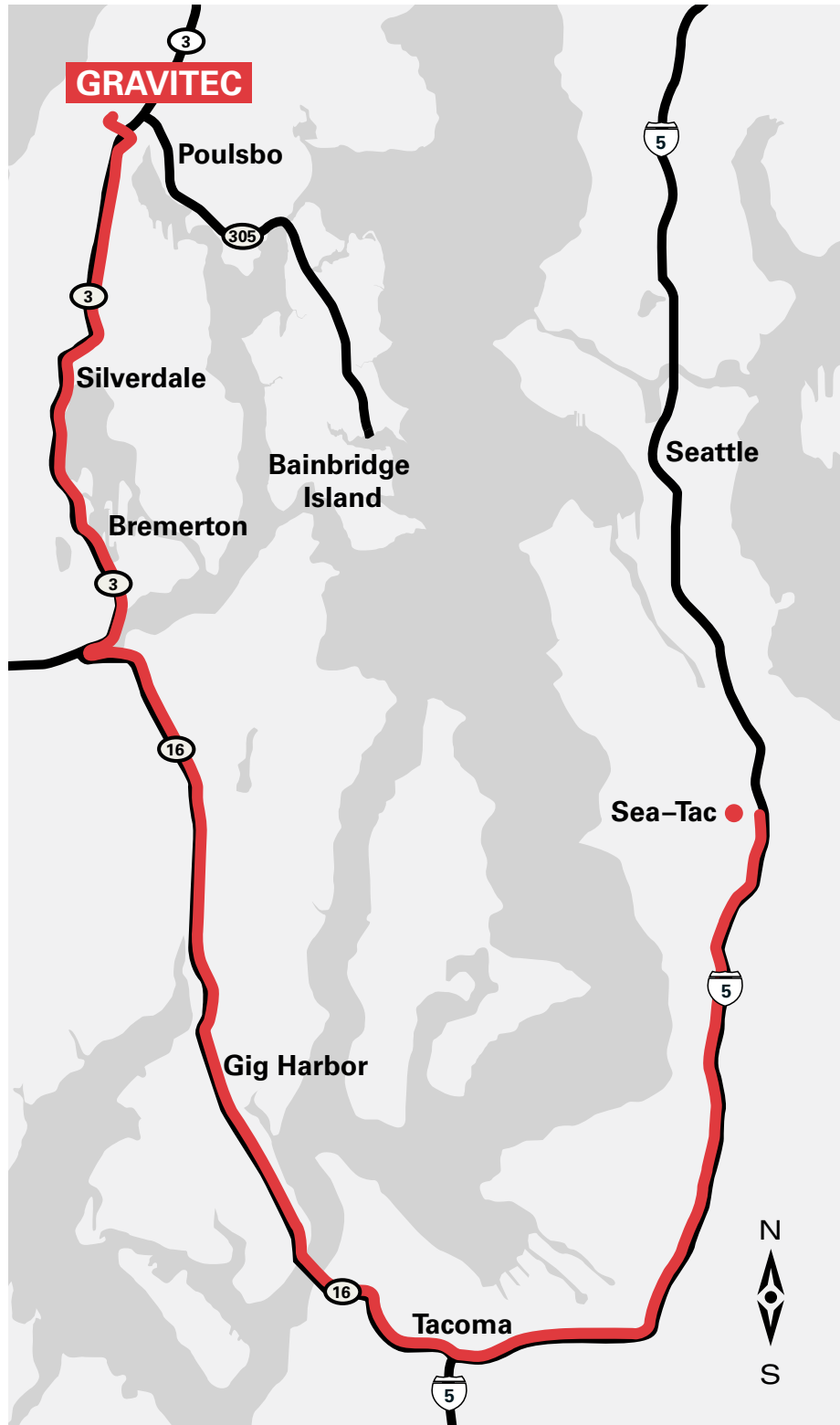
DETAILED MAP TO THE SEATTLE/BAINBRIDGE FERRY

Get on WA-518 E from Airport Expressway.

Take I-5 South toward Tacoma (21.7 mi).

Take exit 132 toward WA-16 W toward Gig Harbor / Bremerton.

Keep right at the fork to continue on Exit 132B, follow signs for Gig Harbor/Bremerton/WA-16 W.

Keep left and merge onto WA-16 W.

Merge onto WA-3 N towards Bremerton.

Take the Finn Hill Road Exit (0.3 mi).

Turn Left onto NW Finn Hill Road (0.4 mi).

Take the 3rd Right onto Urdahl Rd NW (0.3 mi).

Gravitec Systems is the 1st driveway on the left.

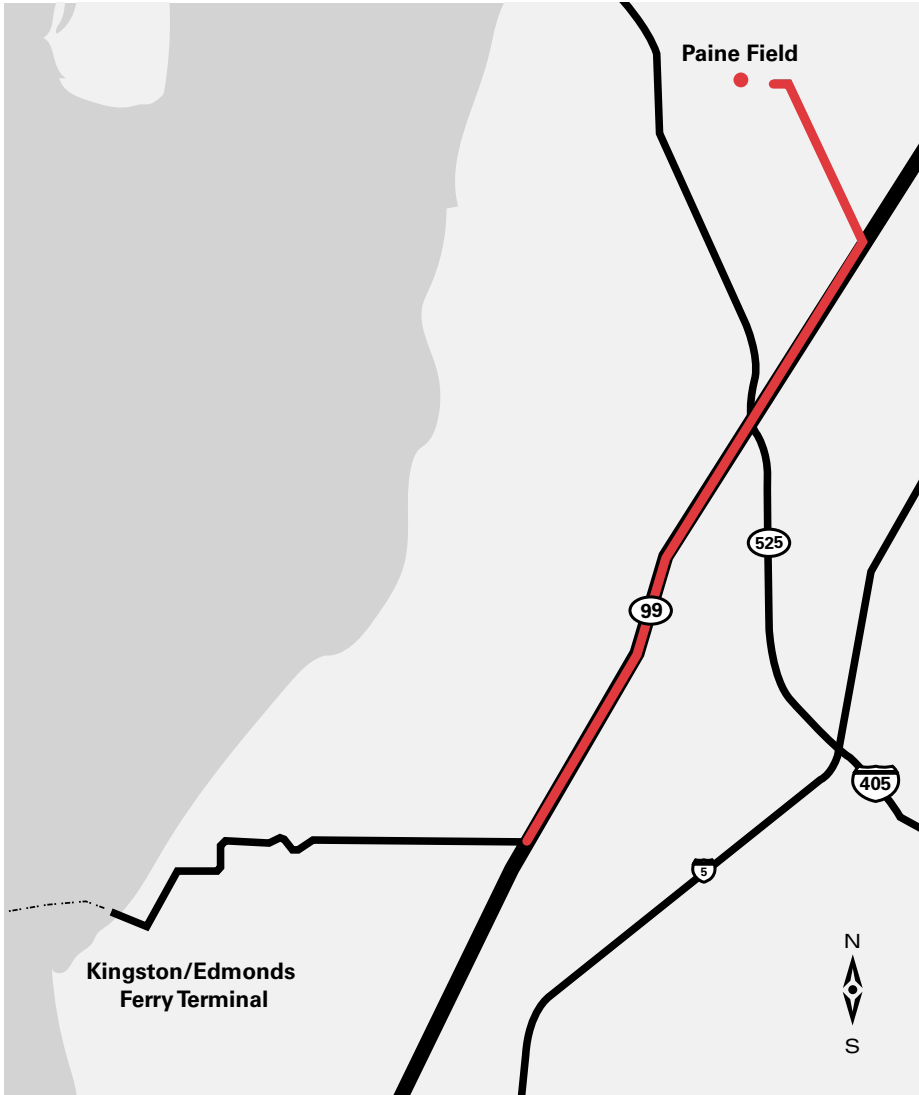

Turn right onto WA-524 W/196th St SW.

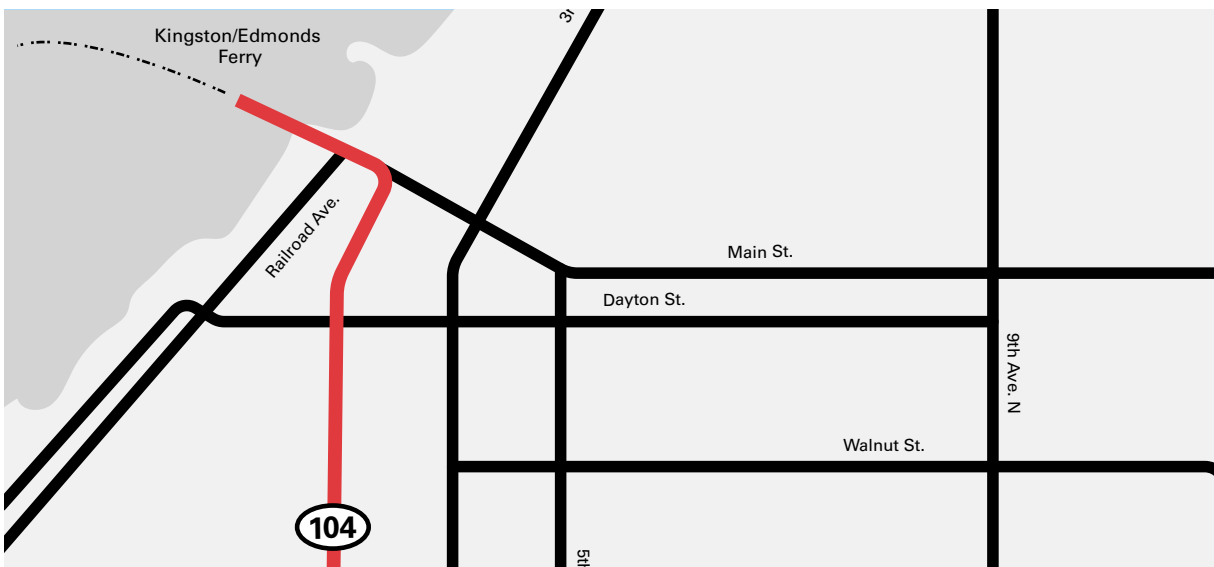
Turn right onto Main Street.

Continue onto WA-104 W.

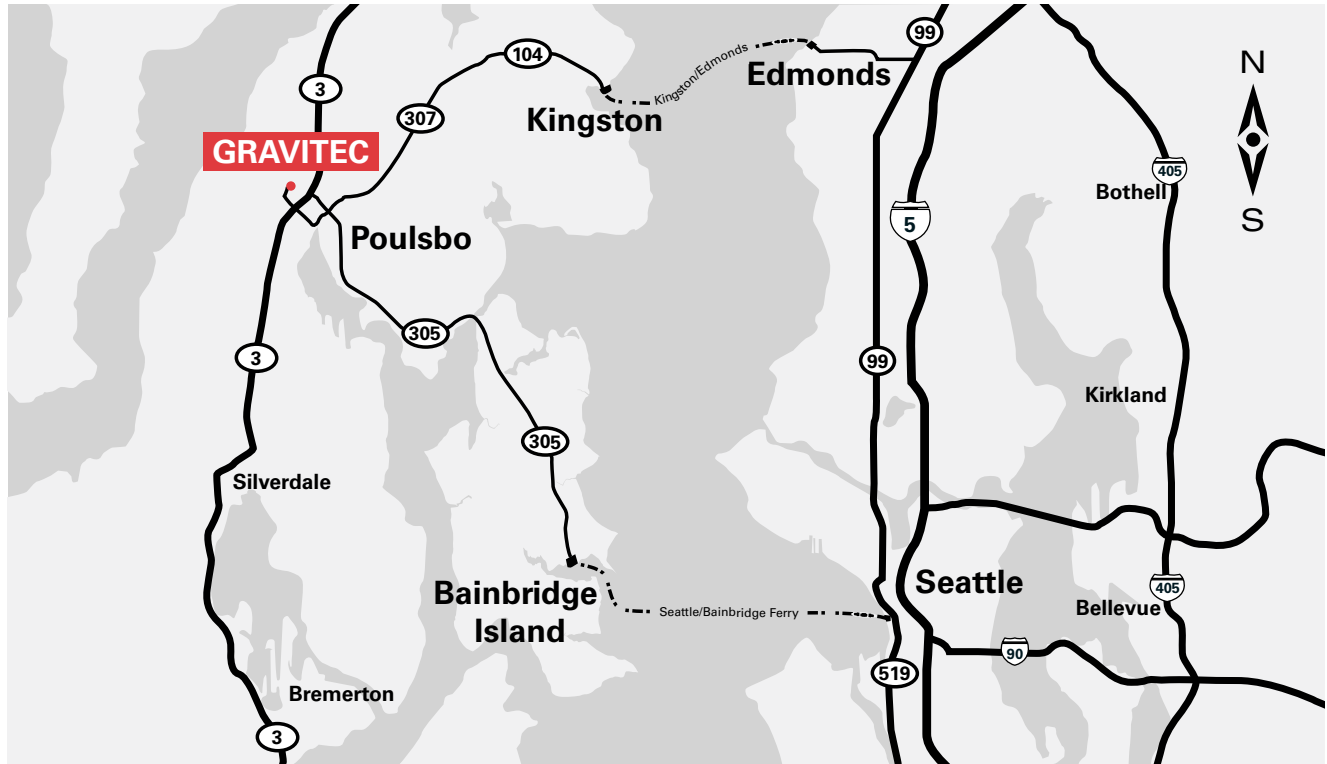
